

Heart of Hoi An

or tourists in Hoi An wishing to choose a hotel in the heart of the town, the Hoi An Hotel is the perfect place, beautifully located on Tran Hung Dao Street and within easy reach by foot of the various attractions the ancient town has to offer.

Hoi An Hotel was one of the first hotels in town, opening in 1991. Together with the strong development of tourism in the town, the Hoi An Hotel has been expanded and upgraded to a four-star hotel equipped with modern amenities of international standard.

The hotel has a nice spacious garden with lotus plants and a water lily pond, colourful flowers, green grass and oak trees, making it special in the heart of the town. It has been built in the style of an old Hoi An house, with all rooms elegantly designed in traditional decor of dark wood furnishings, white crown mouldings, stylish

lighting fixtures, and muted colour schemes, which reflect the atmosphere and beauty of ancient Hoi An town. Each guestroom has a private front balcony and a spectacular view of the spacious garden. The hotel offers use of a large, outdoor pool with deckchairs, a Jacuzzi, tennis courts, a souvenir shop and art gallery, a beauty salon and a tour desk. Children can frolic in the kid's

playground, while corporate guests have access to conference rooms, a business centre and wi-fi.

The Oaks Terrace restaurant brings a contemporary European brassiere style to Hoi An as an all-day dining venue set among oak trees. It serves an international a-la-carte menu for lunch and dinner as well as theme parties. Indochine Corner Restaurant, meanwhile, features a traditional Asian interior with open air, indoor seating where guests can enjoy traditional Vietnamese and other Asian dishes. At Western Bar, an alfresco-style bar that

offers a colourful panoramic view of the pool and the garden, guests can enjoy a wide range of Italian cuisine, including pastas, salads and pizzas straight from a wood-fired oven.

One of the favourite activities for guests is joining a cooking class, which presents a chance to visit Hoi An's colourful market and experience its amazing sights, sounds and aromas. They can also drive to Tra Que vegetable village and walk through the market gardens where local farmers work in their fields using traditional, centuries-old agricultural methods.

You can also wake up early in the morning and join a free tai chi session in the garden, then enjoy breakfast and listen to the birds singing. The hotel offers a free shuttle bus from the hotel to Cua Dai Beach every day, and has a free tourism information centre where you can book tours with the support of friendly staff.
